Below are the results from the spectrometer pointing survey carried out on the Electron (left) arm on May 9th, 2002.

The central ray of the spectrometer is at -40.070 degrees.
It is missing the defined target center by 2.15 mm upstream,
and 0.04 mm vertically (positive = up).

If the offset is corrected by secondary alignment, the
spectrometer will be at 319.916 degrees.
