Below are the results of the recent elevation survey for the new Radcon wells located at the south east of the accelerator site. The elevations were tied into the east horizontal control point which is defined as 32.99 feet above sea level. Elevations for the wells are given to the casing (_C) and the PVC tube (_P). Well A is closest to the south linac.
