

Scientific Symposium *in honor of* *Larry Cardman's* *Contribution to Nuclear Physics* *June 8, 2011 1:30 - 5 p.m.* *Reception Afterwards*

This year saw Larry Cardman step down as Associate Director for Physics after leading the physics division for over fourteen years. During that period, he led the highly successful program of experiments at 6 GeV, and oversaw the development of the case for the 12 GeV upgrade. With the 12 GeV upgrade now firmly established, and with an exciting program of experiments emerging, it is appropriate to hold a scientific symposium in honor of Larry Cardman's contribution to the Jefferson Laboratory program and to our understanding of nuclear physics.

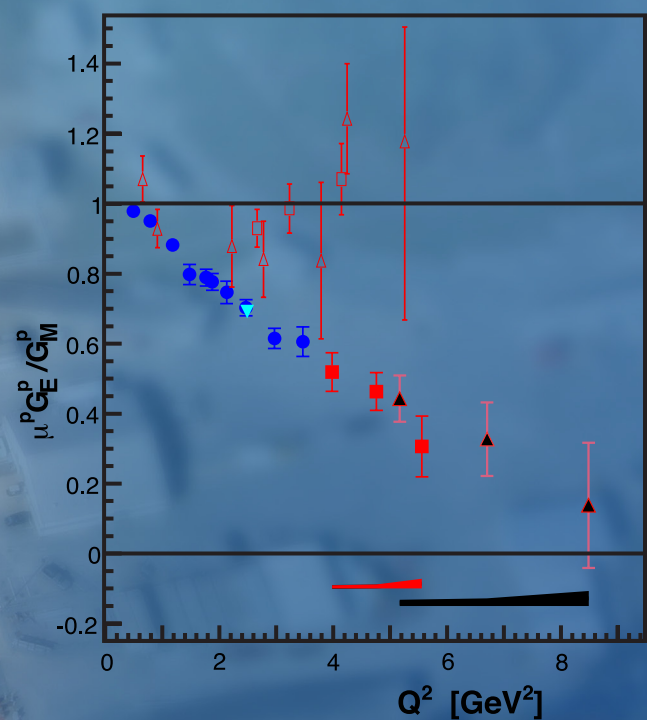
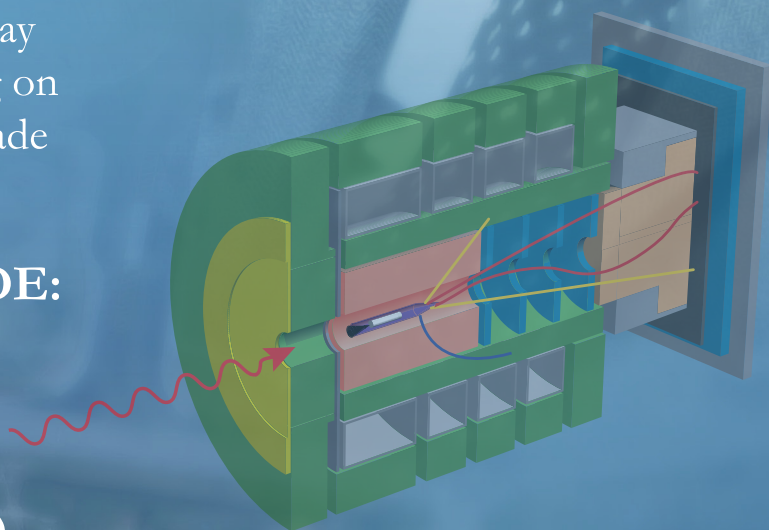
