 - Each case contains padding to support quartz bars

3. Quartz bar disassembly process

George Jacobs, Greg Kalicy, and Beni Zihlmann

- 1. Multiple quartz bars are glues end-to-end to make one, 4-m long bar
- 2. Several 4-m bars are glued to an end plate
- 3. Entire assembly is encased in an aluminum box
- 4. General procedure
 - Remove aluminum box from crate
 - Move entire aluminum box into disassembly area
 - Remove aluminum box
 - Remove end plate from 4-m bars
 - Disassemble 4-m bars in to shorter ~1.5-m bars
- 5. Beni will get information as to dimensions and weight of aluminum box
