Requirements and Assumptions

- Windows XP, Windows Vista, Windows 7, or Mac OS X
- 802.11 [a, b, g, or n] Wi-Fi network interface
- A device capable of Wi-Fi WPA or WPA2 encryption with preshared key (PSK)
- Basic knowledge of using Wi-Fi (wireless network) on your laptop

Quick Start Instructions

- 1. Select "DOEGUEST" from the list of available wireless networks
- Enter the shared key when prompted, "energy.wireless"
- 3. You can now use the Internet

1. Choose the "DOEGUEST" network from the list of available networks



2. Enter Shared Key "**energy.wireless**" when prompted. Please contact the Service Desk at 301-903-2500 if you need assistance.

Wireless Network Connection	
The network 'DOEGUEST' requires a network key (also called a WEP key or WPA key). A network key helps prevent unknown intruders from connecting to this network.

3. After the correct key is entered, you will receive a "Connected" indication in the wireless network dialog box.



